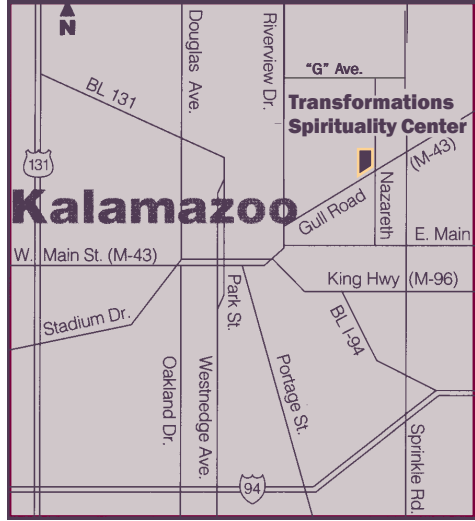


From I-94: Take exit 80 (Sprinkle Road), proceed four miles north on Sprinkle to the intersection with Gull Road (M-43). Turn left onto Gull Rd. Go thru the next light at Gull & Nazareth. The main entrance is immediately on your right—watch for the beautiful stone wall and “Sisters of St. Joseph” sign. Turn onto the property and continue to the 4-way stop. Transformations Spirituality Center is west of the main entrance. Follow the signs for parking.
